



Pattern for Granny Triangle



Materials: Any yarn- I used Scheepjes Catona 4ply (100% mercerized cotton) 25g, **Yarn A** 1 ball kiwi (205), **Yarn B** 1 ball spruce (244), **Yarn C** 1 ball parrot green (241), 3.00mm hook, yarn needle, scissors

Abbreviations: ch: chain, ch sp: chain space g: gram, mm: millimetres, rep: repeat, ss: slip stitch, st(s): stitch(es), tr: treble

To Work:

With yarn A make 4ch, ss into 1st ch to form a ring

Round 1 3ch (counts as first tr here and throughout), 2tr into the ring, 3ch, (3tr into ring, 3ch) two times, ss in top of first 3 ch to join, fasten off

Round 2 Join with yarn B into any corner ch-sp, 3ch, (2tr, 3ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, * 2ch, (3tr 3ch, 3tr) in next corner ch-sp, repeat from * once more, 2ch, ss in top of first 3 ch, fasten off

Round 3 Join with yarn A into any corner ch-sp, 3ch, (2tr, 3ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, * 2ch, 3tr in next ch-sp, 2ch, (3tr 3ch, 3tr) in next corner ch-sp, repeat from * once, 2ch, 3tr in next ch-sp, 2ch, ss in top of first 3 ch, fasten off

Round 4 Join with yarn C into any corner ch-sp, 3ch, (2tr, 3ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, * 2ch, (3tr in next ch-sp, 2ch) two times, (3tr 3ch, 3tr) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * once, (2ch, 3tr in next ch-sp) two times, 2ch, ss in top of first 3 ch, fasten off

Round 5 Join with yarn A into any corner ch-sp 3ch, (2tr, 3ch, 3tr) in same corner ch-sp, * 2ch, (3tr in next ch-sp, 2ch) to end of side, (3tr 3ch, 3tr) in corner ch-sp, repeat from * on next side, (2ch, 3tr in next ch-sp) to end of side, 2ch, ss in top of first 3 ch, fasten off

Round 6 Join with yarn B into any corner ch-sp and repeat round 5

If you want a larger triangle then continue repeating Round 5 until the desired size... enjoy!

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
