



Crocheted Bluebell



Materials: Any scraps of 4 ply or DK yarn could be used for this small project but I used Yarn and Colours 'must-have-minis' 4 ply in Lavender (56) and Peridot (83), craft wire 15cm in length, 3.00mm hook, yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker

Abbreviations: ch: chain, cm: centimetres, dc: double crochet, htr: half treble, mm: millimetres, ss: slip stitch, st(s): stitch(es), tr: treble

Pattern Notes: The bluebell is made in a continual spiral. You may want to use a stitch marker to place in the 1st stitch of each round.

To work Bluebell:

Make 4 ch, ss into 1st ch to form ring

Round 1 (RS) 1ch (does not count as st), 6dc into ring [6 sts]

Round 2 2dc in each st around [12 sts]

Round 3 – 8 1dc in each st around

Round 9 *(1htr, 1tr, 1htr) all in next st, ss in next st, repeat from * to end, ss to first htr, fasten off and weave in ends.


To work Stem:

Make 25 ch,

Place next to craft wire



ss into second ch from hook going under craft wire to ensure wire is encased in sts,



ss in next ch going over craft wire



Continue with 1ss in each ch to end alternating between going under then over craft wire so it is incorporated into the stem as shown above

To Complete:

Thread end of craft wire into bluebell



To attach stem to bluebell make 2 ss with peridot to top of bluebell



Fasten off, thread both ends of peridot through to inside of bluebell, tie a knot to secure, bend craft wire so bluebell has its characteristic droop...
