



'Rosebuds or Golden Studs'

One simple stitch pattern, two different colour combinations and three designs. A dog collar cover, a jam jar cover and a simple crochet bracelet. Of course, there are endless possibilities for these bobble stitches – these are simple suggestions for just a few! 😊

Materials:

- Any DK weight smooth yarn will work well for these projects and stitch pattern. I used a DK acrylic, but wool, cotton or a yarn mix will work well too. Only a small quantity of yarn is needed so these are lovely stash busting projects.
- A 4mm crochet hook or a hook size that is appropriate for your tension and chosen yarns.
- A yarn needle and scissors.
- You'll also need a dog collar for the dog collar cover, a jam jar for the jam jar covers and a small button for the bracelet.



Pattern Notes:

- Each design follows the same basic pattern with a bobble in the centre and the amount of double crochet stitches either side varying depending on the design and desired width.

Abbreviations in UK crochet terminology:

bobble: see special stitches

ch: chain

cm: centimetres

dc: double crochet (US single crochet)

mm: millimetres

RS: right side

rosebud bobble:
see special stitches

ss: slip stitch

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

yoh: yarn over hook



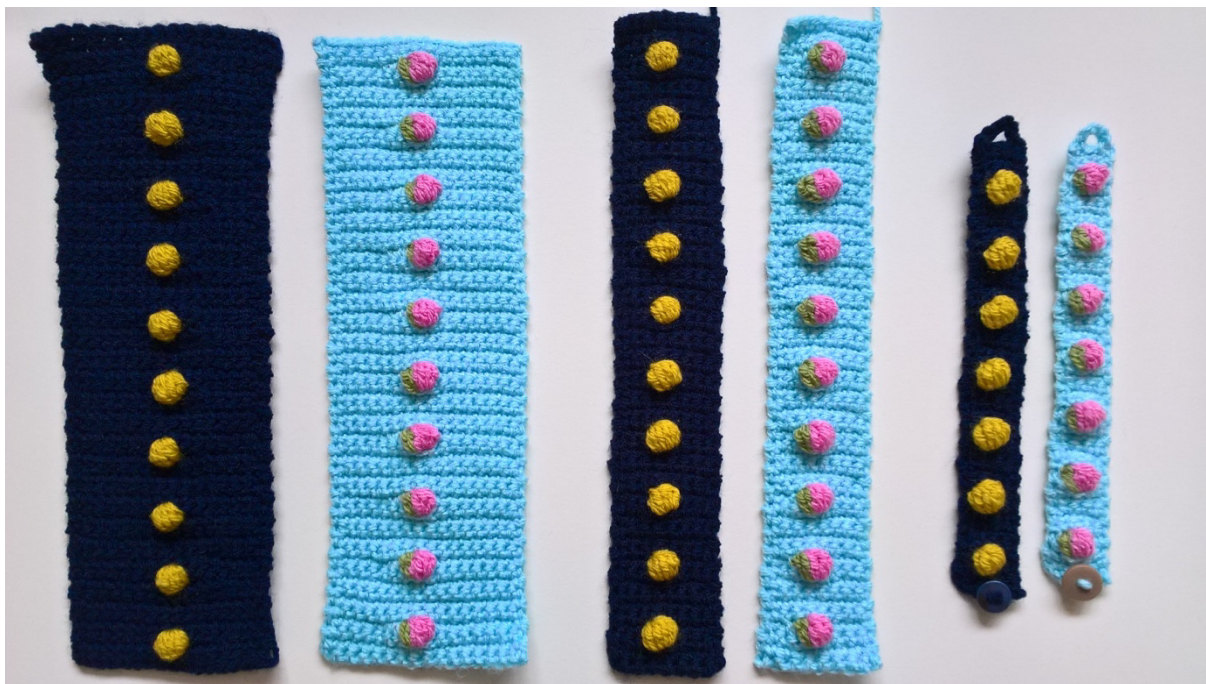
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Special Stitches:

Bobble: Complete all the following in the same stitch: with contrasting colour yarn *yarn over hook (yoh), insert hook into st, yoh, pull contrasting yarn through to front, yoh, pull through 2 loops, repeat from * 5 times more (you should now have 6 contrasting colour loops and 1 main colour loop on hook), pull main colour yarn through all the loops on the hook (1 bobble made), continue with main colour, push bobble towards front of work, carry contrasting colour yarn along behind work and crochet next stitches around it to carry yarn along invisibly behind the work.

Rosebud bobble: Complete all the following in the same stitch: (with pink yarn yoh, insert hook into st, yoh and pull up a loop, yoh and pull through 2 loops) four times, (with green yarn, yoh, insert hook into same st, yoh and pull up a loop, yoh and pull through 2 loops) two times, there should now be 1 loop in main colour, 4 loops in pink and 2 loops in green on the hook, using main colour, yoh and pull through all 7 loops on hook.

To Work



Dog Collar Cover

This pattern is designed to fit a small dog collar approximately 1.5cm in width. For wider collars simply start with more chains in the foundation chain. Ensure an even number of chains are made so that there will be an odd number of stitches and the bobble is made into the middle stitch of the row.

To work Rosebud collar:

With Main Colour make 10ch.

Row 1 (WS) 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, continue with 1dc in each ch to end, turn. [9 sts]

Row 2 (Double Crochet Row) 1ch (does not count as st here and throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn. [9 sts]

Row 3 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 4 (Bobble Row) (RS) 1ch, 1dc in each of first 4 sts, complete a rosebud bobble in next st, continue with main colour, 1dc in each of next 4 sts to end making sure it is crocheted tightly, push bobble towards front of work, turn.



Row 5 – 9 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 10 Repeat bobble row.

Continue to repeat Rows 5 – 10 until desired length to fit collar is reached, finishing with 3 double crochet rows, fasten off leaving a tail of yarn long enough to sew the long sides of the cover together over the dog collar.

To Complete:

Wrap cover around the dog collar lengthways and using the tail of yarn sew the long edges together weaving in any leftover yarn at the end. Weave in all other ends. Your dog now has a gorgeous collar-enjoy!

To work Golden Studs collar:

Follow instructions for Rosebud Collar but work the bobbles in only one solid golden colour.



Crochet Hook Holder (Jam Jar Cover)

This pattern is designed to fit a jam jar approximately 9 cm in height. For taller jars simply start with more chains in the foundation chain. Ensure an even number of chains are made so that there will be an odd number of stitches and the bobble is made into the middle stitch of the row.

To work Rosebud Jam Jar Cover:

With Main Colour make 18ch.

Row 1 (WS) 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, continue with 1dc in each ch to end, turn. [17 sts]

Row 2 (Double Crochet Row) 1ch (does not count as st here and throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn. [17 sts]

Row 3 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 4 (Bobble Row) (RS) 1ch, 1dc in each of first 8 sts, complete a rosebud bobble in next st, continue with main colour, 1dc in each of next 8 sts to end making sure it is crocheted tightly, push bobble towards front of work, turn.

Row 5 – 9 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 10 Repeat bobble row.

Continue to repeat rows 5 – 10 until desired length to fit around jam jar is reached, finishing with 2 double crochet rows, fasten off leaving a tail of yarn long enough to sew the short sides of the cover together over the jar

To Complete:

Wrap cover around the jam jar and using the tail of yarn sew the short edges together weaving in any leftover yarn at the end. Weave in all other ends. You now have a fabulous crochet hook holder (or you can use it for anything else you wish) - enjoy!

To work Golden Studs Jam Jar Cover:

Follow instructions for Rosebud Jam Jar Cover but work the bobbles in only one solid golden colour.



Bracelet

To work Rosebud Bracelet:

With Main Colour make 6ch.

Row 1 (WS) 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, continue with 1dc in each ch to end, turn. [5 sts]

Row 2 (Double Crochet Row) 1ch (does not count as st here and throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn. [5 sts]

Row 3 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 4 (Bobble Row) (RS) 1ch, 1dc in each of first 2 sts, complete a rosebud bobble in next st, continue with main colour, 1dc in each of next 2 sts making sure it is crocheted tightly, push bobble towards front of work, turn.

Row 5 – 9 Repeat double crochet row.

Row 10 Repeat bobble row.

Continue to repeat Rows 5 – 10 until desired length to fit wrist is reached.

Complete 2 double crochet rows

Final row (to make button loop) 1ch, 1dc in each of first 2 sts, 4ch, miss 1 st, 1dc in each of final 2 sts, fasten off.

To Complete:

Weave in all ends, sew button in place on opposite side of bracelet to button loop, pop it on your wrist, fasten button and look fabulous!

To work Golden Studs Bracelet:

Follow instructions for Rosebud Bracelet but work the bobbles in only one solid golden colour.
